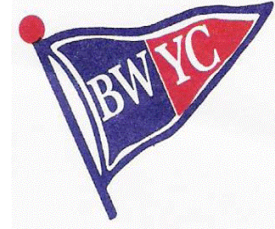

NORTH AMERICAN FLYING SCOT CHAMPIONSHIPS

June 27-July 2, 2010

It is not too late to get involved in the Flying Scot North American Championships. Volunteer to help or just come to your club and visit with the sailors and spectators from all over the United States. The sailing promises to be highly competitive and the parties are always great fun.

On June 27-July 2 sixty (60) boats traveled to the Coast to participate in the North American National Championship Regatta for the Flying Scot Association (FSNAC.) Competitors have come from all over the United States and have had opportunity to visit the local area businesses. Along with the participants there will be spectators so a crowd of about 250 is expected.

The women and juniors races were held on Sunday June 27. Qualifying races for the finals were held on Monday and Tuesday, June 28 and 29. As we went to press the regatta had not begun but results are available on our website www.baywavelandyachtclub.org.

The championship regatta will be held on Wednesday June 30, Thursday July 1 and Friday July 2 with 2 races scheduled for Wednesday and Thursday and one final race on Friday. All races will have a warning signal at 1300.

BWYC sailors have a history of winning this event. Marc Eagan won in 77-78-85-86-90 and 2005. Bubby Eagan won in '89 at the BWYC and Rod Stieffel won in '93. Andrew Eagan, who is competing this year, crewed for the winning team skippered by Allen Terhune, Jr. from Eastport Yacht Club, Annapolis MD in the March 2010 FS Mid-Winter Championships at SYC. Come cheer our sailors to Victory.

The final banquet will be held at the BWYC on Thursday evening July 1 and the trophy presentation will be Friday July 2 immediately following the final race.

Bay Chapter CCA working with DMR to get fishing reefs established using Hurricane Katrina rubbish.

The first 6 are underwater reefs, which are Limestone. The Fred Bourgeois reef is the above water reef in front of Buccaneer Park. These were hand picked by a handful of CCA Bay Chapter Members, who volunteered to come up with locations for the Reefs. Gene Taylor's office (thank him when you see Him) got our permits in our hands in under 10 months which is unheard of. We (CCA) then worked with DMR and started getting the materials. Most of the above water reef was from local contractors and is still being staged at Washington Street Pier under the direction of Buddy Zimmerman and Joey Boudin. Monroe's, St Clare, and Oak St. reefs are situated for wade fisherman access. These reefs can be waded out to and casted over by wading out to these reefs. These locations are the only areas in Hancock County that this can be done because of the drop off from the sand beach to 8 ft of water being so close. We wanted the first above water reef to be located at Long Point to protect and possibly rebuild part of the small strip left Post Katrina, between Long Point and Heron Bay. If something is not done soon, Heron Bay will be the Mississippi Sound. DMR chose our second site in front of Buccaneer as the first above water reef.

ARTICLE XXVIII; FLAGS AND SIGNALS

3. The **Past Commodores**, **Fleet Captain**, Fleet Surgeon, Measurer, Treasurer, Secretary, **Fleet Chaplain**, and **Junior Commodore** may display their flags, which flags shall be prescribed by the Board of Governors.

THE EXISTING BYLAW

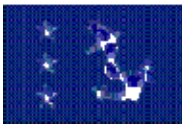
ARTICLE XXVIII; FLAGS AND SIGNALS

3. The Fleet Surgeon, Measurer, Treasurer and Secretary may display their flags, which flags shall be prescribed by the Board of Governors.

NOTE #1: The new language is underlined and in bold print.

NOTE #2: This change would become effective immediately upon its passage.

NOTE #3: Following is a print of the new flags that will be prescribed and designated by this amendment.

NOTE #5: This is a revision of the similar amendment that was published in the June issue of the BWYC Jib Sheet in which action was tabled and/or postponed until the July meeting of the BWYC Board of Governors. This revision corrects a typo and the omission of the Past Commodores flag.

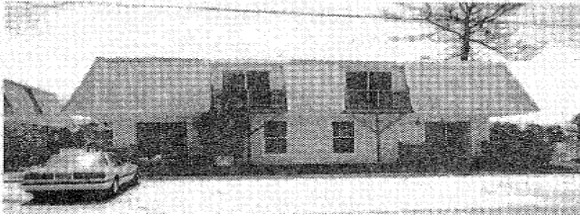

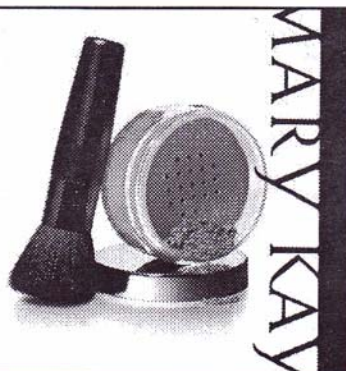
