1. RULES
 - a. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
 - b. National prescriptions for participating classes will apply.
2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY
 - a. The regatta is open to classes of Sunfish, 420, Optimist, Flying Scots, Portsmouth and Finn.
3. FEES
 - a. \$10.00
 - i. Sunfish, Finn, and Optimist
 - b. \$15.00
 - i. 420, Scots, and Portsmouth
4. SCHEDULE
 - a. Registration: Saturday: 10:00 Hrs – 12:00 Hrs
 - b. Competitor's Meeting: Saturday: 12:00 Hrs
 - c. The Race Warning Signal: Saturday: 12:55 Hrs
 - d. No scheduled events at BWYC, enjoy the pool, feel free to Grill Your Own Steaks...
 - e. The Race Warning Signal: Sunday: 12:55 Hrs
5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS
 - a. Sailing Instructions will be available at the registration desk.
6. THE COURSES
 - a. Flying Scots- start between "orange floating mark" and "orange line flag" on the pier, continue through "Diamondhead Cut-off", enter Jourdan River, turn to Port and continue down the to mouth of the Jourdan River, then finish between "orange floating mark" and the "blue line flag" on the pier.
 - b. Portsmouth- start between the "orange floating mark" and the "orange line flag" on the pier, round Jourdan River Mark #5 leaving it to Port, honoring all marks entering the river and round an "Orange Mark" close to the mouth of Bayou La Croix to port. Going south to the mouth of the river and honoring all marks, leaving Jourdan River #5 starboard and finish between the "orange floating mark" and the blue line flag on the pier. Times will corrected on Portsmouth ratings
 - c. Sunfish and 420's will start between the "orange floating mark" and the "orange line flag" on the pier, honor Jordan River #5, leaving it to port, honor all channel marks, then round Cameron Island leaving it to your port, returning to the mouth of the river and honoring all marks and leaving Jordan River #5 to Starboard, finishing between the "orange floating mark" and the "blue line flag" on the pier.
7. SCORING
 - a. The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.
 - b. One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
 - c. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This modifies Rule A2.
8. AWARDS
 - a. All participating classes will be awarded Trophies at the BWYC Crawfish boil to follow after the race on Sunday April 25.
